FREE MEALS FOR STUDENTS

The USDA announced a waiver extension that will allow children access to free meals through June 30, 2021.

What Does This Mean For Moniteau School District Families?

- We have been providing free meals to all students since the first day of school.
- Students can receive 1 breakfast and 1 lunch at no cost for each day school is in session.
 - Extra items are available to be purchased in addition to the meals.
 - If a complete meal is not taken, individual items will be charged at the a la carte price. Ex: A carton of milk is not a complete meal and will be charged \$0.55 each.
- This program will remain in effect until June 30, 2021 or until the USDA does not have available funding. We will notify you of any changes in funding.
- Funds currently available on your student's meal account will remain on their account for use when the USDA waiver expires.
 - Please be sure to complete your Free and Reduced Priced meal application now to determine if your students are eligible to continue meal benefits after June 30, 2021.

- Drive-thru meal service pick-up is offered every Friday from 1:30 p.m. 2:00 p.m. at the Dassa McKinney Elementary School. Meals can be picked-up for all children age 18 and younger. Please reserve your meals each week online at https://tinyurl.com/moniteaumealpickup.
